In preparation for the party, please bring a bag of individually wrapped candy to the church by Sunday, October 20<sup>th</sup> so that treat bags can be prepared for the children attending the event.

Preliminary proceeds for this year's Virginia Mennonite Relief Sale is \$383,033 as compared to last year's final sale proceeds of \$370,181. These funds support Mennonite Central Committee (MCC) for worldwide relief, service and peacebuilding programs throughout the world. Our congregation contributed items that were sold for \$8,172.

Our "My Coins Count" money jar amount was \$1,264.71 compared to \$437.60 last year. The total of all 27 jars this year was \$24,804 compared to \$23,542 in 2018. These funds are divided between two agencies – MCC and VMissions. The MCC project is for improving the health of communities through water and sanitation in Jordan. VMissions funds will be used to partner with local churches to host soccer camps and medical clinics that serve refugees in Jordan, and to help Jason Wagner who shares the love of Jesus with jail inmates and disciples them in faith.

Matthew Smith and his band Indelible Grace will be at Williamsburg Community Chapel, Saturday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, 7 PM. An offering will be taken that night with a suggested donation of \$10 per person or \$20 per family. More information is on the bulletin board.
